God tells us:

In John 17:3 – (Jesus speaking) “This is eternal life that they may know You, the only True God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.”

In I John 5:11-12 – “And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has the life, he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life.

In I John 5:20 – “And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding so that we may know Him who is true, and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and Eternal Life.
