

## Temple of God?

What do you think of when you read this? Did you know that your body is the Temple of God? (If you are a follower of Jesus Christ.)

So much of the world is immodest. There are several ways in which we can be immodest, in our speech, our behavior, and in the way we dress. Webster's Dictionary defines "immodesty" as lewd, obscene and impure.

**1 Tim.2:9** says, "In like manner also that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety: not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly array." **Note:** this does not say that just Christian women adorn themselves. This scripture refers to all women and men, believers and non-believers!

**James 1:14&15** – "But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust and enticed. Then when lust hath conceived it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death."

**Romans 14:13B** – "No man put a stumbling block or an occasion to fall in his brothers way." The lack of dress cause's both men and women to lust, to stumble. **Matthew 5:28** say's "But I say unto you, that whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her, hath committed adultery with her already in his heart." (This applies to women and men, believers and non-believers.) **Exodus 20:14** – "Thou shalt not commit adultery."

Shamefacedness means: bashful, excess of modesty. Sobriety means: seriousness. Are we being bashful and serious when we dress? Immodesty does not favor a certain age group or women over men. In fact immodesty is prevalent in both young and older women and men, girls and boys. Immodesty is a form of rebellion, a form of drawing attention to oneself. **Ps. 94:4B** – "and all the workers of iniquity boast themselves?"

Immodesty leads to immorality? **1Thes 4:6A** states "That no man go beyond and defraud his brother in any matter." **No man or woman** to defraud his brother or sister in any matter. Whether you are a follower of Jesus Christ or not this scripture is plain enough to understand. Go beyond means: to overstep. Defraud means: to take advantage of. Defrauding a brother or sister, taking advantage of them by leading them to lust after our body, **this is SIN!**

## Can you see the importance of modesty?

If you are a follower of Jesus Christ your body is the "Temple of God." **1Cor.3:16 & 1Cor. 6:19** – "What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost, which is in you, which ye have of God and ye are not your own?" Immodesty grieves the Holy Spirit of God. **Eph, 4:30** states, "And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God wherein ye are sealed unto the day of redemption." Ask God to show you how to become a modest person, whether it is in your speech, your behavior or in the way you dress. **1Tim.2:9!!!**

If you are not a follower of Jesus Christ please read the following scriptures to know how you can be a child of God and obtain eternal life through Jesus Christ, and become modest in all you do.

**1 John 5:13**

**Romans 3:10, 3:23, 5:12, 6:23**

**Romans 10:9-13**

Bow now to your knees and pray to God. Acknowledge that you are a sinner and ask Him to forgive you of all your sins. Tell Him you need Him and acknowledge His death on the cross and how His shed blood has cleansed you from all sin. Ask Him to come into your heart and save you **NOW!**

**John 2:15** – “Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world the love of the Father in not in him.”

**Titus 2:12** – “Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world.”
